**REGARDING RELEASE OF INFORMATION**

Dear Doctor and Staff:

I am an employee of Union Pacific Railroad. If you are treating me as the result of an injury I sustained while at work on the railroad, there is special information that you need to know.

**THERE IS NO STATE WORKER'S COMPENSATION ON THE RAILROAD, and MEDICAL BILLS ARE NOT COVERED BY WORKER'S COMPENSATION INSURANCE.** Injuries sustained at the railroad are covered by federal law, which is not related to State *or Federal* Worker's Compensation laws. So you do not need to, and should not, fill out any Worker's Compensation forms. Likewise, you should not send any information to the state agency that administers Worker's Compensation.

**Please submit all bills to my health insurance.**

**DO NOT PROVIDE ANY INFORMATION ABOUT ME OR MY MEDICAL CONDITION OR CARE TO ANYONE, INCLUDING THE RAILROAD, *WITHOUT A RELEASE SIGNED BY ME AFTER THIS DATE***, even if the railroad contacts your office for information.

I hope this information is helpful and will avoid any confusion or complications.
